The A.F.V.P. will provide:

- Ongoing risk and safety assessments based on the Family Safety Framework risk assessment;
- Assertive outreach case management - going to the woman wherever they feel comfortable;
- Children's responses (focusing on trauma), advocacy, referrals to services, and case work with schools;
- Support for women to safely re-engage back into their communities and with family connections.
