- Keep Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children connected to their culture.





WHAT ARE CHILD DEVELOPMENT SCREENINGS?

- Child development screenings help monitor whether a child is meeting the milestones for their age (such as taking a first step, smiling and talking for the first time).
- Looking at the following areas: communication, movement, problemsolving and personal-social skills.
- Using a cross-cultural adaptation of the Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) developmental screening tool to identify Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children with possible developmental concerns.
